Market Summary:

Trading value for Thursday 05/02/2015 reached JOD (11.7) million. (13.7) million shares were traded through (5,071).

The shares price index closed at (2220.77) point, a decrease of (0.13%).

The shares of (141) companies were traded, the shares prices of (54) companies rose, and the shares prices of (50) declined.

At the sector level, the Industrial index decreased by 0.39%, the Services index decreased by 0.13%, and the financial index increased by 0.12%.


Orange Jordan looks to solar energy to cover 50% of its

Almost half of Orange Jordan's energy needs will come from solar power by the end of this year, according to Raslan Deiranieh, the company's deputy CEO. The company has floated a tender for building a solar farm to meet some 50 percent of its energy needs, Deiranieh recently told The Jordan Times. The project, which is expected to be operational at the end of 2015, will generate some 25-30 million kilowatts a year, which covers half the company's annual needs of 55-60 kilowatts, according to Deiranieh. The solar energy project, which will be managed by the winning bidder, will save the company around JOD 3 to JOD 5 million a year, he added.

Oil Minister confirms Iraq's desire to strengthen ties with Jordan

Oil Minister Adel Abdul Mahdi confirmed on Wednesday Irag's desire to strengthen relations with Jordan and expand the size of the joint cooperation, especially in the field of oil and energy. A statement by the Ministry of Oil said that "Abdul-Mahdi met today with the Jordanian ambassador in Baghdad, Mohammed Mustafa al-Goraan, to discuss issues of common interest between the two countries, especially in the economic and energy fields and ways of development issues.

Figure 5: Value Traded





Figure 5: Trading Volume
