• World Bank: Jordan faces daunting short-term challenges due to the Syrian conflict


Jordan is shouldering a particularly heavy economic and social burden from the worsening of the Syrian crisis as estimates show a negative impact of about one percentage point on Jordan's GDP due to the conflict, a senior World Bank official said. The crisis has also created a large scale population exodus which Jordan is struggling to absorb (620.000 registered refugees as of October 2014), and the additional demand for public services is adding a significant burden to the country's already weak public finances, Inger Andersen, Vice President, Middle East and North Africa at the World Bank told Petra in an interview on the sidelines of the recent WB-IMF meetings. She pointed out that the WB has stepped in with a combined loan and grant package of about \$200 million to help Jordan maintain access to healthcare services and basic household needs and help municipalities strengthen their service delivery capacity.

• Ras Al Khaimah to promote free trade zone at HORECA in Jordan

tableware and guest amenities, as well as engineering, architecture, consultancies, schools and universities.

Figure 5: Value Traded





Figure 5: Trading Volume
